Rising 6th – 12th Grade Audition Requirements

Dance

Ballet, Modern, Jazz – Student must wear leotards and tights or tank top and biking shorts with bare feet. Do not prepare a memorized dance. If accepted, the student must buy specific attire and will be required to wear hair in a classical bun for classes and events.

Music

Piano – Two contrasting pieces (piano is provided).

Vocal – Prepare 2 songs to sing from memory that you feel will best show off your vocal abilities. You may sing “Amazing Grace,” “My Country ‘Tis of Thee,” musical theatre selections, or any other selections of your choice.

Strings – Students should be prepared to perform the following: 2 octave scales in flat and sharp keys, sight-read music at a medium level, perform a solo level 3 or above, and match pitch/ rhythm examples.

Theatre

Student must be prepared to perform a memorized 1-2 minute monologue. Please do not choose a piece from a classical play, instead pick an age appropriate monologue. Student must also prepare a short song from a Musical or Disney show (just a verse and a chorus). Student may bring a musical cd track to sing with or you can sing acapella.

Visual Art

Student must bring 8-10 examples of current artwork. Student must bring his or her own drawings using pencil, watercolor, crayons, cut paper designs, collages, sculpture with cardboard or clay, etc. Please do not bring cartoons. Draw from nature and the world around you. Auditioning includes drawing in the classroom, paragraph writing and a brief interview. Students who do not have art work to show are not eligible to audition.
