Background

- By federal law (ESSA) we are required to identify schools that are identified as Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), & Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) schools beginning with the 2018-19 school year.
- Mississippi Code Title 37. Education § 37-18-1. Superior Performing Schools, Exemplary Schools, and Schools At-Risk Programs established.
- The MS State Consolidated Plan, also known as MS Succeeds provides the specific criteria for identifying and addressing schools as required by ESSA.



Identifications

Federal Identifications

- Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI)
- Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)
- Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI)

State Identification

- School At-Risk (SAR) **Mississippi Identification only**



School Improvement Categories

CSI Identification

- Graduation rate less than or equal to 67%; OR
- Bottom 5% of Title IA schools; OR
- Previously identified ATSI school with 3 consecutive years of subgroup proficiency performance (no improvement)...ID begins in the 2021-22 School Year

TSI Identification – Underperforming Subgroup

- Subgroup in lowest 50% of overall accountability index; AND
- Subgroup in lowest quartile of 3-year average gap-to-goal; AND
- Subgroup scores in lowest quartile of 3-year improvement toward gap-to-goal closure
- Results are rank-ordered and bottom 5% are identified for TSI

ATSI Identification – Consistently Low Performing Subgroup

- 3-year average subgroup performance is at or below that of all students in the lowest performing schools

SAR Identification

- Accountability letter grade of “F”

CSI/ATSI Identification Methodology

- ED requires the SEA, in accordance with section 1111(d)(2)(C) of ESEA, to identify any subgroup that is performing as poorly as the schools identified for CSI, as ATSI using the same methodology.
- The MDE will now use 3 years of data to identify CSI schools including schools identified in the fall of the 2022-2023 school year which aligns with the way ATSI schools are currently identified.



MDE ESEA Addendum

- Data years for School Improvement identification in the Fall of 2022 were **2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2021-2022** for CSI and ATSI identification.
- Delayed the requirement for more rigorous options (MROs) for CSI schools and the ATSI to CSI escalation for at least 1 year – this will affect schools re-identified in the Fall of 2023
- Identifications will be back "on-cycle" Fall 2023

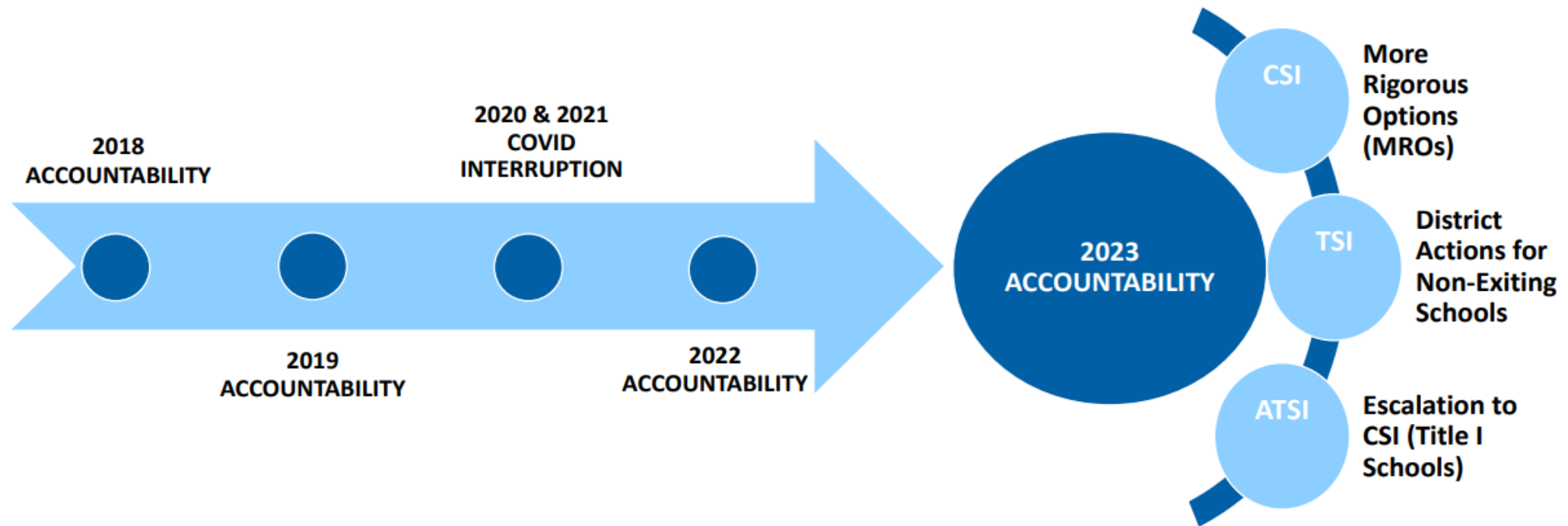
