



Free COVID Vaccinations

Jackson Public Schools has partnered with Jackson Hinds Comprehensive Health Center to provide COVID-19 vaccinations to staff and students 18 years of age and older.

The Moderna vaccine will be administered. This vaccine requires two doses 28 days apart. Participants must present their vaccination card to receive their second dose. Vaccination cards will be given to those receiving their first dose. No ID is required.
