What Is the U.S. Census?



The U.S. Census is a constitutionally mandated, decennial count of all persons living in the United States.



This year, the Census can be completed by **paper**, **online**, **or by phone**. This is the first time for an online delivery mechanism.

Historically, communities of color and low-income communities have been **undercounted** in the Census.
