XIV. Consideration to Hold an Executive Session: Dr. Luckett moved, and Letitia Johnson seconded the motion, to close the meeting to consider entering into executive session. All 7 board members voted in favor of the motion.

Dr. Luckett moved, and Letitia Johnson seconded the motion, to enter into executive session to discuss a proposed settlement of the Henderson v. JPS lawsuit, the Hester v. JPS lawsuit and potential litigation regarding a claim by Teach for America. All 7 board members voted in favor of the motion.

In executive session, District Counsel, JoAnne Shepherd, first informed the board of a claim for payment by Teach for America arising out of its provision of services during this current school year. Attorney Shepherd explained that district administration inadvertently failed to present the contract for services to the board for approval prior to commencement of services. Attorney Shepherd recommended that she be authorized to file a quantum meruit petition seeking court approval to pay Teach for America's claim for services in the approximate amount of \$110,000. After discussion, Dr. Luckett moved, and Letitia Johnson seconded the motion, that Attorney Shepherd's request to file a quantum meruit petition seeking approval to pay Teach for America be approved. The motion was unanimously approved.

Next, Attorney Shepherd informed the board of the status of the Hester v. JPS lawsuit. The district's insurance carrier has settled the suit for \$95,000, and Attorney Shepherd is seeking approval to pay the district's portion of the proposed settlement, namely, its deductible, in the amount of \$38,000. After discussion, Dr. Sivak moved, and Dr. Luckett seconded the motion, that Attorney Shepherd's request to disburse the district's portion of the settlement be approved. Additionally, in an effort to avoid future lawsuits of this nature, district administration will bring to the board, within the next 45 days, for its information, proposed procedures regarding payment of part-time employees. The motion was unanimously approved.

Finally, Attorney Shepherd updated the board on the status of the Henderson v. JPS lawsuit. She recommended that the board authorize settlement of the lawsuit for \$14,000. After discussion, Letitia Johnson moved, and Dr. Sivak seconded the motion, to approve the settlement in the amount of \$14,000. The motion was unanimously approved.

There being no further business to discuss in executive session, Dr. Luckett moved, and Letitia Johnson seconded the motion, to exit executive session. All 7 board members voted in favor of the motion.

Upon returning to open session, Letitia Johnson moved, and Dr. Luckett seconded the motion, to adjourn the meeting. That motion was unanimously approved.
