The board heard from Ms. Veals and her attorney, Damon Stevenson, and members of district administration. The board's findings and decision are set out in the order attached to these minutes.

There being no further business to discuss in executive session, Dr. Luckett moved, and Mrs. Hilliard seconded the motion, to exit executive session. All 6 board members voted in favor of the motion.

Upon returning to open session, Dr. Luckett then moved, and Mrs. Hilliard seconded the motion, to adjourn the meeting. That motion was unanimously approved.

ORDER UPHOLDING RECOMMENDATION OF 4-DAY SUSPENSION OF CYNTHIA VEALS

In accordance with Miss. Code Ann. Sections 37-9-59 and 37-9-111, the Board granted Cynthia Veals ("Veals") an opportunity to appear before it to present a statement on her behalf prior to the Board making a final decision on the superintendent's recommendation of a 4-day suspension of Veals for exercising poor professional judgment. Veals and her attorney, Damon Stevenson, were present to make a statement on Veals' behalf. The Board had also previously reviewed the transcript of the hearing and hearing officer's report submitted by Nathaniel Armistad, Esq., hearing officer.

During its deliberations, the Board determined that, on August 21, 2019, Veals had an encounter with a male student who was behaving in an unruly and uncontrolled manner. During the encounter, Veals tried to stop the student from entering a classroom and physically manhandled him. Video footage of the encounter reflected that, contrary to Veals' initial description of the encounter, Veals approached the student from behind and aggressively swung him around. Veals' physical contact with the student was not initiated from a defensive posture and the student's conduct at the time, while inappropriate, posed no physical threat to Veals. The extremity of Veals' conduct constituted poor professional judgment and justified the imposition of a 4-day suspension.

After discussion, Dr. Hairston moved, and Mr. Figgers seconded the motion, to uphold the Superintendent's recommendation of a 4-day suspension of Veals.
