LEGAL ITEMS AND SERVICES WHICH MAY BE PURCHASED

Only legal items and services may be purchased and paid for from budgeted school district funds. A legal item is defined as those directly associated with the operation, maintenance, repair or construction of schools and school equipment. Such items must be essential to an effective school program. No personal items may be purchased and paid for with taxpayer's money.

Legal items must likewise be legally purchased utilizing the established purchasing process.
