

**POSSESSION OF WEAPONS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS
OR AT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES**

The Jackson Public School District believes that the schools and school functions should have an environment that is safe and conducive to learning and other educational purposes. Because of the Board's grave concern for the safety of the District, and in order to protect the scholars, staff, visitors, and guests of the District, the Board hereby prohibits the possession of pistols, firearms, or other weapons by all staff, scholars, visitors, or guests in all school district buildings, district vehicles, on district grounds, or at school activities whether on-campus or off-campus. A specific exception exists for the Office of Campus Enforcement, who are certified in law enforcement, other duly authorized law enforcement officials and others as the law allows. Visitors who lawfully possess an enhanced carry permit may enter only in those areas permitted by law.

Any person found carrying such pistols, firearms, or weapons is subject to disciplinary or other appropriate action.
