NONRESIDENT STUDENT

A nonresident student is defined as one whose parent or legal guardian is not a legal resident of this school district.

Applications for admission by a non-resident student who wishes to attend school in the district shall be made at the superintendent's office or designee's. If admitted, the student shall be assigned to a school, provided tuition is paid in advance for each school month at the scheduled tuition rate established by the board.

The principal shall withhold the appraisal report and cumulative records student who owes tuition and shall refuse admission to any student who fails or refuses to pay the tuition.
