VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

Parents, volunteers, and other members of the community are encouraged to visit and volunteer in the schools. Parents who wish to observe their child in the classroom must inform the teacher or principal to avoid any possible conflicts with the school schedule.

All visitors to schools shall report immediately to the school office, sign in, and obtain a visitor's badge so that visitors can be readily identified by school personnel. Exceptions to this requirement are when visitors are attending a general school function such as a pep rally, assembly program, athletic event, etc.

The District will not tolerate visitors to school premises who threaten, intimidate, physically or verbally abuse District staff, or otherwise disrupt the school or office environment. Unauthorized persons shall not be permitted in school buildings or on school grounds. School principals are authorized to take appropriate action to prevent such persons from entering buildings or from loitering on school grounds. Such unauthorized persons will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
