Pursuant to Mississippi Code 37-13-91, a parent, guardian or custodian of a comage child in this state shall cause the child to enroll in and attend a public school nonpublic for the period of time that the child is of compulsory-school-age. An uabsence is an absence by any compulsory school-age child missing for thirty-sex (37%) or more of a school day, in which the absence is not due to a valid excuse nonattendance.
