# **Directions for Summer Reading Log**

- 1. **Read your book,** either by yourself or with another person. Reread parts that you especially like or that seem most important.
- 2. Think about your book. If possible, talk to another person about some or all of these questions:
  - What scene in the book stands out in your memory?
  - What was the main character like?
  - Did the main character change during the book?
  - Was there a problem and how was it solved?
  - What would you have done if you had been in the story?
  - What new thing did you learn in this book?
  - Does the story remind you of something that happened to you? If so, how is your experience like the book?
- 3. Complete a Log Entry.
  - Write the title and author of your book.
  - Use the questions above to draw and/or write about your book.
- \* Required titles should be read by scholar rising from the previous grade to next grade level. Scholars in Grades PreK-1 are required to read
  the required title and select two titles of choice. Students may choose from a list of ten titles (see Summer Reading page), from the public
  library's list, or other sources.
